Today marks the first day of Stoptober – our annual mass participation quit smoking campaign. A huge thanks to everyone who has already downloaded and used our campaign toolkit and assets over the last few weeks - it's great to see so many examples of local activity from organisations across the country!

If you have yet to downloaded the campaign resources there is still time to get involved in Stoptober and help encourage smokers to make a quit attempt. Remember - if they can make it to 28 days smoke-free, they're fives times more likely to quit for good. We have lots of campaign resources available including digital posters, graphics for digital screens and a suite of social media assets.

It's important to keep campaign activity running throughout October to support anyone making a quit smoking attempt. This could include sharing stories of people who have quit successfully or offering tips on things like managing cravings and signposting to the range of quit support available. As well as signposting to your local services, there's a range of quit smoking support tools and information available on the Better Health quit smoking website.
