The aim of this workshop is to support you in shared decision making with people who are starting, restarting or changing contraception within the NHS Pharmacy Contraception Service (PCS).

After completing all aspects of this workshop, participants should be able to:

- Apply appropriate person-centered consultation skills to enable an effective medical history to be taken
- Explore the suitability of oral contraception for people who access the service in accordance with their individual needs and in line with the service specification and PGDs
- Discuss information and guidance regarding contraception options to allow the person to make an informed choice on an appropriate contraceptive for them
- Provide information on long-acting reversible contraceptives and discuss their advantages, side effects and suitability for people using this service
- Support people to explore their concerns or side effects linked to contraception and be able to discuss alternative options.
