Services activity information **Hypertension Case-Finding Service - BP & ABPM Activity**

The pressures being experienced from dispensing income and rising costs are leading more BSol contractors to seek ways to increase revenue through delivery of advanced services.

The LPC will be publishing periodic services activity information to support contractors to make decisions about which services to offer by sharing publicly available data (usually NHSBSA).

This report is the second Hypertension Case-Finding Service quarterly update the LPC has shared with contractors and will be repeated in March 2026.

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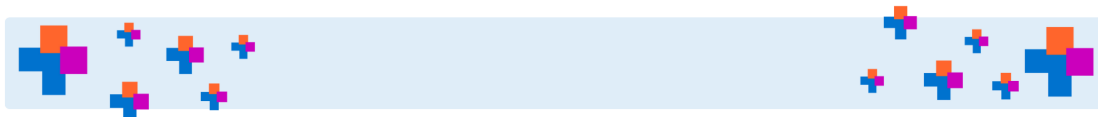
