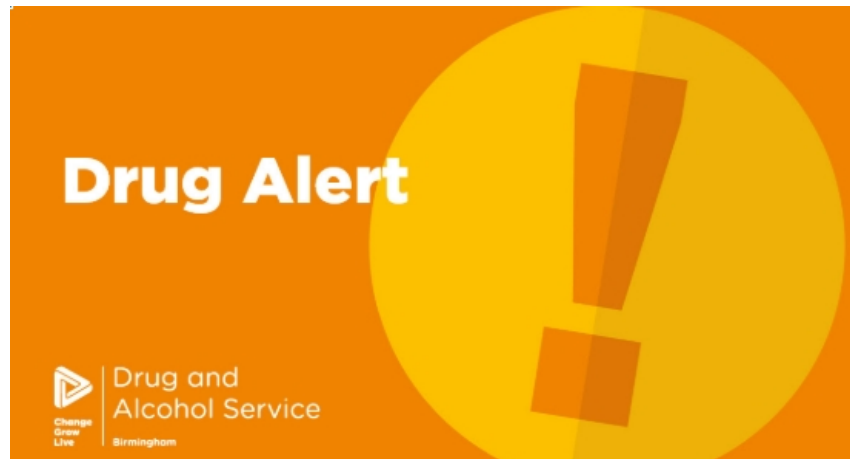

Drug Alert - Batch of Mamba with Unexpected/Severe Effects - Birmingham City Centre

We've been made aware of a **potentially dangerous batch of mamba** currently circulating in Birmingham city centre.

Local officers have recently responded to an incident involving someone who had used mamba. **The individual became very unwell very quickly, with their condition deteriorating far more severely than would normally be expected.**

They experienced:

-  **Very shallow breathing**
-  **Vomiting**
-  **Becoming extremely unwell very quickly / collapsing**
-  **Loss of consciousness**

They required CPR and hospitalisation.

Please be aware of the increased risk and share this with anyone who may use Mamba, or support those that do.

If You Use Mamba:

Go Low, Go Slow – Try a small amount first, as strength and effect is unpredictable.

Avoid Using Alone – Take care of each other in the case of any adverse reactions.

Try Not to Mix Drugs/Alcohol – Avoid using with other drugs or alcohol, as that may increase the risk of negative effects.

Call 999 – Call 999 immediately if anyone shows serious symptoms. *If they're breathing and at risk of vomiting, put them in the recovery position or at least on their side to avoid choking.*

Avoid Shaking or Startling – If someone is unresponsive, follow the advice of the 999 call handler. Shaking can worsen adverse reactions.

If you are not in drug treatment, please consider referring yourself in for ongoing support, harm reduction advice and so we can keep you informed of any other alerts.

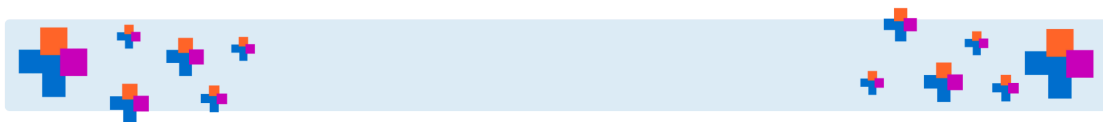
