Reminder for community pharmacy contractors: amendment to temporary suspensions approved particular

Community pharmacy contractors are reminded that the reporting mechanism for temporary service suspensions will be changing from **Monday 1 June**.

What is changing?

Notifications must be made via the **MYS platform** from 1 June and manual notifications to ICBs will no longer be permitted (except in the very rare circumstances when the MYS platform is unavailable).

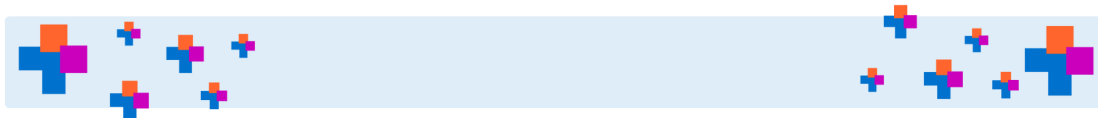
