CPCF services and Terms of Service - Important dates

This page provides a list of important dates for the Community Pharmacy Contractual Framework (CPCF) which relates to various services including:

- COVID-19 vaccination services
- Pharmacy Medicines Service (PMS)
- Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS)
- Pharmacy Quality Standard (PQS)
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This page is a 'live' page and will be updated as and when announcements and dates are confirmed. Pharmacy owners are encouraged to check back regularly to ensure they have the most up-to-date information.

Pharmacy owners are reminded to review the CPCF Services and Terms of Service - Important Dates page to ensure they are aware of key deadlines.

Current highlights:

31st July deadline for completing the 2026/27 CPAF screening questionnaire, quarterly NHS website and Directory of Services (DoS) profile reviews, and upcoming Pharmacy Quality Scheme (PQS) and vaccination service dates.

July 2026

Between 1st July and 30th September 2026

- **ToS:** Deadline for meeting the requirement to ensure pharmacy owners have verified and, where necessary, updated the information contained in their [NHS](#)

[website](#) profile and their [DoS](#) profile for 1st July to 30th September 2026 quarter of the financial year.

This is a mandatory requirement for all pharmacy owners.

13th July 2026

- **MenB:** Patients can start to book appointments for the service via nhs.uk/book-menb.
- **PQS:** Aspiration payment window opens at 9am.

20th July 2026

- **MenB:** Start date for the MenB service.
- **ToS:** Community Pharmacy England webinar on the regulatory provisions and issues around pharmacy core and supplementary opening hours. **Action:** [Register for the webinar](#) if you are interested in learning more on this topic.

11.59pm on 20th July 2026

- **MenB:** Deadline to register for the MenB service. Registrations submitted after this time will not be accepted and the pharmacy will not be able to provide the service.

28th July 2026

- **PQS:** Aspiration payment closes at 11.59pm.

31st July 2026

- **COVID-19:** Deadline for pharmacy owners that want to register to provide the COVID-19 Vaccination Service from the anticipated autumn/winter campaign. Pharmacy owners can continue to register after this date, but they are not guaranteed to receive supplies of COVID-19 vaccine in time for the start of this campaign. If they have registered to provide the service for the spring campaign, they do not need to re-register.
- **Flu:** Pharmacy owners are encouraged to register to provide adult flu vaccinations for 2026/27 by this date to inform local system planning for autumn/winter.
- **ToS:** Deadline to complete the 2026/27 CPAF screening questionnaire for pharmacy owners. **This is a mandatory requirement for all pharmacy owners and the results of the questionnaire will form the basis of which pharmacy owners will be asked to complete the full CPAF survey and may be visited later. Action:** Pharmacy owners should complete the CPAF screening questionnaire before 11.59pm tonight.

August 2026

1st August 2026

- Pharmacy First: Updated Pharmacy First caps come into force for August 2026. Action: If not already done so, check the [NHSBSA website](#) to see what your Pharmacy First cap is for this month.

17th August 2026

- Flu (Childhood and Adult): The National Booking Service (NBS) opens for all participating sites to post flu appointments. Action: If you are using NBS, add your appointment slots to the system.

31st August 2026

- Flu (Childhood): Pharmacy owners must have registered by 11.59pm on the MYS portal to receive vaccine ahead of the commencement date of the service (1st October 2026). Pharmacy owners can register after this date and before the registration deadline; however, it is not guaranteed they will receive vaccine in time for the service commencement date.

August 2026 (Dates TBC)

- PQS: The Palliative and End of Life Care questionnaire (PEoLC) will be published on the [NHSBSA website](#). Pharmacy owners must complete this by the end of 31st December 2026. Since this is a requirement of the gateway criterion, if this deadline is missed, pharmacy owners will not be able to make a PQS declaration.
- PQS: The clinical services audit will be published on the [NHSBSA website](#).

Please ensure all relevant actions are completed before these deadlines.

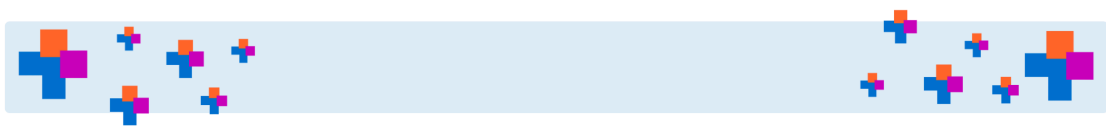
