URGENT – For Contractors Signed Up to Deliver the MenB Service

Please read and action the information below

NHS England has published new guidance on MenB vaccine distribution, which may affect your first week's appointments.

The initial potential challenge for pharmacy owners relates to the initial supply of MenB vaccine (10 doses per pharmacy) and a mismatch with the number of appointments a lot of pharmacy owners have posted on MYA/NBS for their first week of vaccinations. We are advising in a website news story (link below) that pharmacy owners to review their MYA/NBS appointment slots for their first week offering the vaccine.

Note - NBS goes live to patients on Monday.

Action Required

Please review your MYA/NBS appointment slots for the first week and amend them if needed to reflect your initial vaccine allocation.

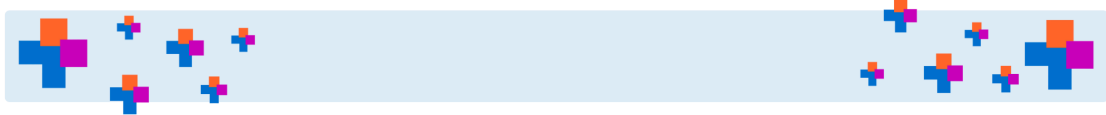
